With current national circumstances, the imposed tariffs on products and materials we supply have in turn increased prices. We will do our best to keep those prices and price increases to a minimum to help with the cost to the end consumer.

July 3, 2018-Lincoln Electric

As you are all aware, the Trump Administration finalized its Section 232 Tariffs on June 1, 2018 for Steel (25%) and Aluminum (10%) products, removing the exemptions from the EU, Canada and Mexico. These tariffs went into effect immediately. These last-minute changes have had a dramatic impact on the input costs for most of our consumable products. Understanding the fluid nature of these tariffs, Lincoln Electric has decided to implement a Tariff Surcharge to cover these increased costs.

June 21, 2018-ITW Welding North America-Miller

This round of tariffs will have a significant impact on the cost of our raw materials and imported finished goods. After a careful assessment of our product lines and supply chain, we are implementing tariff surcharges as stated below. These surcharges will be effective with products shipped on or after July 2nd and are in addition to previously announced tariff surcharges and price increases.

Hobart Brothers' Tariff Surcharges: Surcharge Aluminum (4000 and 1100 series part numbers only) 4% Stick Electrode 5% Solid Wire 10% SubArc Solid Wire (SDX) 25%

Hobart Brothers' Tariff: Surcharges previously implemented on April 2, 2018. Surcharge Stainless Steel Solid Wire 25% HB Solid Wire 25% All tubular wires, 5000 series aluminum, Stainless Stick, SubArc Flux 0%
